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What will follow is a series of STREAMpreneur sample activities which you can take and use in your own setting. For our audio listeners, the next few segments you will have to watch as there are visual components that cannot be fully described in words. This is the case for segments 4.5, 4.6, 4,7 4.8 and 4.10. 4.9 and 4. 11 you can merely listen to if you prefer. Getting back to it, the point of the sample activities, is not going to be the activities themselves. The point is the thinking that goes into our intention to use any activity. I would like to ask for caution when you listen and take in these breakdowns because they too are samples of breakdowns. The goal of these videos is to provide you with some insight as to how you can start thinking about the use of STREAM inspired activities.

The point that I would like to make especially clear however is that just because you will see a specific way of how an activity can be used, it does not mean that it is the only way or that you can just take it as it is and implement it exactly like that in your youth group. These are merely suggestions to give you ideas to help you with the formation of connections such as those mentioned at the beginning of the module. Listen to those suggestions, broaden your mind, and then think about your own context and how you can take that activity and tailor it to suit the needs of both your youth group and the topic you are presenting or the skill you are trying to help them build. Last but not least for directors, managers and supervisors watching this, trust your youth workers and your teachers enough to allow them to put their spin on an activity because they spend the most time with the youth and know the dynamics and needs involved. And for youth workers and teachers watching these breakdowns, trust yourselves enough to change the implementation of these activities to fit you and your youth group.





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
