





5.2 CLOSING REMARKS

For Blended learning for example It could take up to 3 years and in some cases more depending on the support and infrastructure that you have at your disposal. Do not be alarmed or discouraged by this time frame and do not rush to implement every single idea in one go as taking on a lot at the same time 1) will put unnecessary pressure on yourself and 2) you will be spread so thin that you will not have adequate time to be intentional and mindful when choosing and implementing certain ideas, thus you will not be as effective as you intended to be.

To close let me remind you that you are not on your own when it comes to this learning journey. First of all, you now have me as an ally which you can turn to for support whenever you need. As you know you can connect with me via LinkedIn or email. Your most important ally however is the one you will find in the youth you work with. Work with them intentionally, collaboratively, listen to them, give them a voice, make them an equal team member, give them ownership in this STREAMpreneur journey that you will take on together. Do that sincerely. If you do that they will get a feeling of belonging, they will feel proud, accountable and engaged. So, partner up with them and discover what education has to offer together.
